

Solid: A substance that takes up space and has its own shape.	Liquid: A substance that has no shape but does take up space. A liquid takes the shape of its container.
Properties of Solids	Properties of Liquids
Color	Opacity: whether it is opaque or transparent Color
Shape	Do not have a shape
Some can roll	Feel: sticky, smooth, silky
Some can stack	
Some can roll and stack	
Hardness: squishy, flexible, very hard.	
Some float and some sink	Some float and some sink (when poured into water)
<u>Magnetism:</u> Some are attracted to a magnet (like a bobby pin or a paper clip) and some are not attracted to a magnet (like a spoon or a cube).	Some are viscous (like glue) and some are fluid (like water).
	Some flows slowly and some drip fast
